



TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE

The tournament will be played in 3 Levels. A dealer button will be used and rotated around the table to each seat number after each hand whether the seat has a player or not.

LEVEL 1

ROUND	MINIMUM BET
1	\$100
2	\$200
3	\$400

Three rounds of eight hands each will be played for a total of 24 hands. Each player must bet at least the minimum bet for each hand. The maximum bet is all in. Players may re-buy any time during level 1 if they have \$5,000 or less in tournament chips. Two players with the most chips from each table will advance to Level II with his/her total chip count.

LEVEL 2

ROUND	MINIMUM BET
1	\$400
2	\$800

Each player has the option to do a single or double add-on, (see #11). Each player must bet at least the minimum bet for each hand, or up to all-in. A total of 16 hands will be played. At the end of level II. The top 8 chip counts will advance to the final table.

LEVEL 3

ROUND	MINIMUM BET
1	\$1,000
2	\$1,000

8 players will be Guaranteed Money.

Hollywood Park Casino Blackjack Tournament rules:

- Each player will start with \$1,000 in tournament chips for \$50. These chips have no cash value. Players may re-buy any time during level 1 if they have \$5,000 or less in tournament chips.
- Players may only bet on their seat position playing against the Dealers hand.
- The Casino Dealer will pay and collect all bets with tournament chips.
- Players may double down on any two cards except a Natural 21.
- Players may split any two cards of the same value. Players may split 2 times for a total of 3 hands. Split aces receive only one card. Players may double down after a split.
- There will be no "Surrender" or "Insurance" offered on any hand.
- Blackjack (21) will pay 2 to 1.
- Players must bet in turn. Once chips are released, you cannot change your original bet.
- The Dealer button will be used to start the betting for each round. The position where the button will start will be random and it will be determined by a card drawn.
- Qualifying players will start with their total amount of chips from the previous Level.
- Each player that qualifies for the semi-finals will be allowed to make a single or double add-on, regardless of their chip count. Single add-on will receive \$2,000 in tournament chips for \$20 or \$5,000 in chips for \$40. Add-on's must be done before you play a hand of Level II.
- At the start of the deal, if a player is away from their seat, a minimum bet will be placed, and the seat will receive two cards face down and the hand will be killed.
